Literacy

This week in literacy we read a new book on Booker T. Washington about his early life and the perseverance he demonstrated in learning how to read. Then they will be starting work on a reading contract they will be writing that describes two reading goals they are making for themselves for this upcoming quarter.

Students learned different strategies that can be used to solve multiplication and division problems (skip counting, repeated addition, repeated subtraction, pictures and arrays).
